

FCA Hockey Senior Interns Program

The Fellowship of Christian Athletes Hockey is seeking three to four men passionate about hockey and Jesus Christ to help lead and facilitate events over the summer. The FCA Hockey Senior Interns Program is an 11-week fellowship designed to train men as ambassadors for Jesus Christ and give them opportunity in ministry. This intensive program will invest significantly in each trainee, where they will be taught and trained through hands-on experience in hockey ministry.

Interns will serve as part of the FCA Hockey Staff where they will gain experience in discipleship, evangelism, ministry operations, leadership, and coaching. Responsibilities will include leading small groups, teaching Bible curriculum, sharing a personal testimony, coaching, planning functions, logistics, helping to facilitate events, and supporting FCA Hockey staff in various ways to advance the ministry.

Interns will also be challenged in their growth spiritually through leadership development trainings aimed at empowering real men of God and fully devoted followers of Christ in the hockey world.

Positions Include:

- Sports Ministry / Coaching
- Creative Media / Photography / Videography

Qualifications:

- Seeking committed, character male athletes who will be able to help grow the ministry.
- Male athletes who can be entrusted with authority and lead initiatives
- Male athletes who have a heart for ministry potentially in the future

Internship Details:

- 11-Week Program. Arrive May 23, 2018. Depart August 5, 2018.
- Interns will work out of the FCA Hockey Headquarters in Alexandria, Minnesota.
 - Housing will be provided through hosts families.
- Interns will serve at 5-7 events and also participate in Warrior Fellowship.

Finances:

- Pay is on an individual basis with base plan being \$4k (\$2k from FCAH, \$2k raised). FCA Hockey will match amount raised by each Senior intern up to \$2k. *For example, if a Senior intern raises \$1k, FCAH will match \$1k.* There is no limit on the amount a Senior intern can raise.
- FCA Hockey will cover all reasonable travel expenses to camps and events, such as airline tickets, camp expenses, and team meals.

Proposed Spiritual Training:

1. Required reading: What Every Christian Ought to Know by Adrian Rogers
2. 6 Training Sessions (*bi-weekly*)
 - a. Session 1: How do you effectively share testimony and the Gospel?

- b. Session 2: How do you lead small groups?
 - c. Session 3: How do you effectively disciple others? What does it mean to make disciples?
 - d. Session 4: What does it mean to be a real man?
 - e. Session 5: What does it mean to be a great leader?
 - f. Session 6: What does it mean to be a great leader? Part 2.
3. Gospel and Testimony Training
- a. Interns will practice sharing the Gospel through various drills.
 - i. 1-minute and 3-minute testimony
 - ii. 1-minute and 3-minute Gospel
 - b. Interns will be taught skills in communicating publicly

FAQ:

• ***Can I train during the summer?***

Yes. Current athletes will have the opportunity to train on and off the ice in Alexandria. Past athletes have trained, worked, and been well prepared for upcoming seasons.

• ***Can I travel home during the summer between events?***

Yes. As schedule allows, interns can request time off as needed.

• ***Will FCA Hockey cover travel expenses to and from Alexandria, MN for the Program?***

No. This expense will need to be covered by the intern.

• ***Where will I live during the summer?***

FCA Hockey will provide housing locally with a host family.
